

Parliamentary Bureau – Approval of Scottish Statutory Instrument

[Regulated Roles \(Prohibitions and Requirements\) \(Scotland\) Regulations 2024 \(SSI 2024/Draft\)](#)

1. Under Rule 10.6.5, the Bureau is required to lodge the following motion—

Jamie Hepburn on behalf of the Parliamentary Bureau: That the Parliament agrees that the Regulated Roles (Prohibitions and Requirements) (Scotland) Regulations 2024 (SSI 2024/Draft) be approved.

Purpose

2. These Regulations set out prohibitions and requirements that apply to organisations only. Organisations are prohibited from permitting an individual to carry out a regulated role and must remove the individual from the regulated role in the following circumstances:
 - Where an organisation, for which an individual is carrying out a regulated role, is notified by Scottish Ministers under section 30(2)(a) of the PVG Act that the individual has been barred from carrying out regulated roles with children or adults.
 - Where an individual is carrying out a type of regulated role for an organisation and the individual does not participate in the Protecting Vulnerable Groups Scheme (“the PVG Scheme”) in relation to that type of regulated role.

Consideration by committee

3. At its meeting on 27 November 2024 the Education, Children and Young People Committee agreed to recommend that the Instrument be approved. The Committee’s [report was published on 11 December 2024](#).

Decision
